LETTER FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Dear Friends, 2022 has been a record-breaking year for Mothers for Others!

We've reached a new distribution record, providing over 275,000 diapers to children in Fairfield County. In the pages that follow, you'll see details about where those diapers went and who we helped.

Each day, we have taken on the issue of diaper need in Fairfield County by getting free diapers to as many children as possible. We have also invested time in raising awareness that basic human needs include diapers, and that this need is not being met for many families in our area.

Diaper need exists in Fairfield County – one in three families report that they have trouble affording enough diapers.

We know the 'dirty facts' about diaper need – the strain the cost of diapers places on already tight household budgets, the health consequences suffered by babies who aren't changed frequently enough, and the increase in parental anxiety and maternal depression when diapers are in short supply.

We know that by getting diapers out to as many children as possible, we are helping to alleviate that burden. But, every week, a new parent or caregiver reaches out to MFO for assistance with diapers. So we ask ourselves, how can we do more?

We are looking ahead to 2023 with a stronger commitment than ever to our mission. We plan to distribute well over 300,000 diapers throughout the coming year. We will continue raising awareness about diaper need and how it affects young families. We are exploring partnerships with new agencies, planning more diaper distribution days, and developing strategies to ensure we can always respond to emerging and emergent needs for diapers.

We feel confident in our ability to achieve these goals – in large part thanks to the supporters we have in our corner. None of our past achievements would have happened, and none of our future goals can be met, without you.

To everyone who has offered us their time and generosity in 2022, we thank you. You are the reason a mother can change her child's diaper when it is needed. You are the reason a father can put money towards groceries instead of diapers. You are the reason parents have taken a sigh of relief, knowing their child has enough diapers to go to daycare. Most of all, you have demonstrated to parents and caregivers that they are seen their need is recognized and their community stands behind them to help provide one of the most basic of needs for their children. Thank you to everyone who has stepped up and supported our mission to keep every child clean, dry, and healthy.

OUR STORY SO FAR

Mothers for Others (MFO) was founded in 2011 by a group of mothers in Greenwich, Connecticut to collect gently-used baby equipment for local families in need. Parents and caregivers could shop our donation room for items they needed for their babies and toddlers. A robust donation network through area nursery schools and businesses ensured that our donation room always had inventory and the operation was run completely by volunteers.

By early 2016, we had become aware that many of our regular families were also experiencing diaper need. MFO's leadership recognized that this was a more acute need than the need for baby equipment.

Leveraging our existing partnerships, we added a diaper bank within the donation room. Local social service agencies referred families, who could receive a package of 50 diapers each month, approximately a one-week supply.

The COVID-19 pandemic in 2020 necessitated a change in our operating model. MFO pivoted from in-person distribution to a more efficient hub-and-spoke model with six partner agencies from Greenwich through Norwalk. We continue to operate this way, with the majority of clients receiving diapers through partner agencies. MFO also continues to distribute diapers from our office on a first-time and emergency basis, as well as through community diaper distribution events.

Since transitioning to operate solely as a diaper bank and a member of the Diaper Bank of Connecticut, MFO has dramatically increased our impact, going from 15,000 diapers in the first year to 200,000+ in 2022. We have now distributed over half a million diapers to families throughout Fairfield County, earning the distinction of the largest independent diaper bank in Fairfield County.



A YEAR IN REVIEW

DIAPER DISTRIBUTION DAYS

MFO hosted a series of Community Diaper
Distribution Days, in which volunteers
brought thousands of diapers to central locations for
families to come and receive a free pack of diapers.
32,720 diapers were distributed at six distribution
events throughout the year.



REFUGEE SUPPORT

MFO provided diapers to newly-arrived children of evacuees from Afghanistan and Ukraine resettling in Greenwich and surrounding towns, Additionally, MFO partnered with two local organizations to send 5,500 diapers directly to organizations providing relief on the ground in Ukraine.



COMMUNITY DIAPER DRIVES

Community Diaper Drives were back this year and bigger than ever! 18 individuals and organizations hosted drives this year. The launch of our Virtual Diaper Drive platform allowed for more diapers than ever to be donated – 88,269 diapers came in through drives this year.



VOLUNTEERS

This year, MFO welcomed back familiar faces and new friends. Whether volunteers were running diaper drives, packing and stacking diapers on our shelves, or handing out diapers at Community Diaper Distribution Days, our dedicated crew helped get diapers to more children than ever.




