



Volunteer Re-Packaging Event

MFO provides one week of diapers (50 diapers) to every child each month. Diapers come to us in different containers - cases, plastic sleeves, etc. With the help of volunteers, we repackage the diapers into bags of 50 for easy distribution to families. Groups of 6-8 people work well and all ages are welcome! We have had friends, high school kids, and girl scouts participate. It takes 1-1.5 hours at our office, and we provide everything. Bring your camera to take photos!

HOW IT WORKS

Packing the Diapers (everyone)

- Pick a station at the table and put on gloves
- Open box of diapers, note which size you are working with
- Count 50 diapers and put into a large zip top bag
- Squeeze out air and seal bag
- Put bag in bin in hallway (marked by size)
- Get a new pack of diapers!

Shelving the Diapers (2-3 people)

- Take full bags from bins in hallway and put them on the correct shelves in MFO donation room
- Count the packs you stack
- Stack bags neatly so they don't fall

Clean up (everyone)

- Dispose of gloves
- Stack extra bags neatly and put on office desk
- Break down boxes to be flat for recycling
